

Proposal #1 from KJ Anderson: Allowing for more than three Novice Policy Tournaments

Revision to Article III, Section C – Policy Debate Rules and Procedures, #2a.

Delete the final sentence and replace with the following:

The novice section shall be offered for the first three preliminary tournaments and may be offered at the remaining two tournaments, at the discretion of the Vice President of Policy Debate, if indicated and feasible based upon the number of novice entries.

Proposal #2 from Roberta Hyland: Audio and Video Recording

Revision to Article III, Section A – General Rules, #6

Adding the following paragraph at the end:

Requests for an exception to this rule must be provided to the WACFL President, the Director of the other Diocese, and the applicable event Vice President by the registration deadline of the tournament for which the exception is being requested. All recording will be restricted to the specific student cited in the request and other students in the room will not be recorded. The individual performing the recording will need to show documentation signed by the student(s) and/or parent/guardian indicating authorization for the recording. All exceptions are conditional upon the League Officers' determination that the recording will not impede the administration of the tournament.

Proposal #3 from Roberta Hyland: Tie-Breaking for Congress Seeding Chart

Revision to Article V, Section F – Metropolitan Championship Tournament Procedures, #4.a.

Add:

(3) Ties in seeding will be broken first by the number of congresses attended, then by the total average score for the student during WACFL preliminary tournaments.
